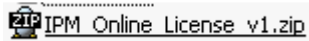


Online License Software

Installation Instructions

1. Unzip the zip file to a folder on your computer.

a. Use your favorite zip program to unzip the file.



b. After you unzip it, you'll see a directory structure like this.

2. Upload the software files to your web hosting account.

You may want to use the “Auto ASCII” mode in your FTP program and let the program decide what format each file should be uploaded in.

If you do not have an FTP program, please either go to Google.com and search for “ftp program”.

Or, here's a link to a free FTP program called, FileZilla:
<http://filezilla.sourceforge.net/>

Please note. You can install this software on a domain name by itself (at the root of your domain) or you can install it in it's own directory. It's your choice and preference.

If you install it on the “root” of your domain, it would load here:
<http://yourdomain.com/>

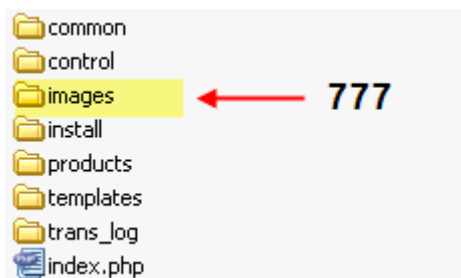
* You'd just replace “yourdomain.com” with your domain name.

If you install it on in a “directory” on your domain, you select which directory. For example, if you wanted to install it in a directory called “shop”, it would load here:
<http://yourdomain.com/shop/>

- a. Upload these files in ASCII mode
 - i. php, txt, css, js, and txt files
- b. Upload these files in Binary mode.
 - i. gif and jpg files
- c. After you upload, change permissions on the following files and folders.

If you do not know how to change permissions of files or folders, please see the documentation for your FTP software or your web host provider.

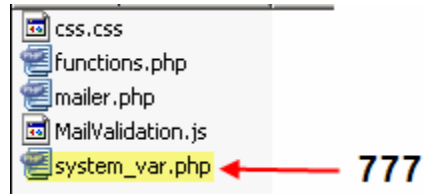
- i. Change the permissions of /images folder to 777



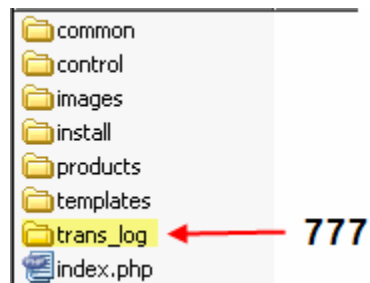
- ii. Change the permissions of the /images/ezines folder to 777



- iii. Change the permissions of the file /common/system_var.php to 777



- iv. Change the permissions of the /trans_log folder to 777.



3. Create a mySql database

- a. The Online License software uses a mySql database. Before you use the software, you will need a mySql database and a username/password with rights to the database.

If you do not know how to create a mySql database and a user with proper right, please contact your web host provider. They should be able to help you.

- b. You will need the name of your mySql database. Maybe name it "license" or "onlinelicense" or something like that so you can easily recognize it.
- c. You will need a user for that mySql database and that user's password.

- i. Give the user the following rights to the mySql database.

alter, create, temporary, tables, create, delete, drop,
select, insert, update, references, index, lock, tables

- d. Just keep the mySql database name, username and password handy for the next step.

4. Open a browser and go to the install URL

- a. Now it's time to go through the install wizard for the software
- b. Open your favorite web browser (i.e. Internet Explorer, Firefox, etc)

- i. Put the following URL in the address bar of your browser.

<http://yourdomain.com/install/install.php>

*Just replace "yourdomain.com" with your domain name.

If you decided to install it in it's own directory, you would put this URL in the address bar.

<http://yourdomain.com/directory/install/install.php>

*Just replace "yourdomain.com" with your domain name and "directory" with the directory you uploaded the software to.

- i. Script Path – this should remain as it is.
 - ii. Domain Name – this is your domain name.
 - iii. Site Name – put your site name here
 - iv. Domain Name – this is where the software is installed on your domain. If you are installing the software in its own directory, make sure you put the directory there.

For example. If you are installing the software here:
<http://yourdomain.com/shop>

Be sure that full URL is in the Domain Name
 - v. Admin email – enter your admin email address.
 - vi. Reply to Email – enter the email address that people to reply to when the software send them emails (thank you emails, receipts, etc)
 - vii. Admin Username and Admin Password – this is for you and it's the username and password you will use to access the Admin area of the software.

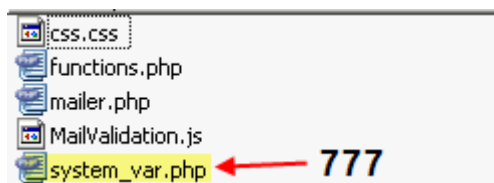
- viii. Page Title – this is the title that will appear on the top left corner of people’s browsers when they visit your site.
- ix. dbHost – this is your mySql database host name. See your host provider for this. 99% of the time it will be “localhost”
- x. dbName – this is your mySql database name
- xi. dbUser – this is your mySql database username
- xii. dbPassword – this is your mySql database password

d. Now click “Install Now”

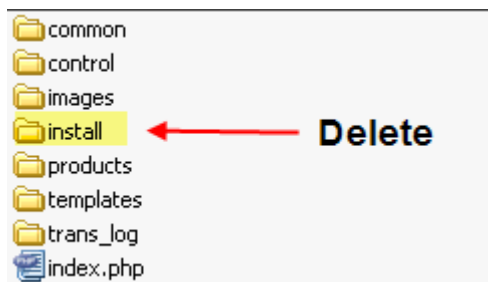
e. If the installation was successful, you will see a page like this.



5. Change permissions on the /common/system_vars.php file to 755



6. Delete the /install folder



7. Disregard the instructions highlighted in yellow below.

- After Successful Installation, delete the following directories
 - + /home/ipmusco/public_html/license/install
 - + /home/ipmusco/public_html/license/templates/install

8. Login to your admin area and begin selling!!!

- a. Your Admin area will be located at this URL

If you installed the software at the root of your domain
<http://yourdomain.com/control/>

*Just replace “yourdomain.com” with your domain name.

If you installed the software in a folder on your domain:
<http://yourdomain.com/folder/control/>

*Just replace “yourdomain.com” with your domain name and
“folder” with the folder you installed it in.

- b. Please note, the installation software will tell you that your username is “webmaster”, but it’s really the username you entered on the install page.
